Jurisdiction

The competition shall be held under the National Sporting code, the Environmental code and standing regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary regulations, which shall be submitted to the ACU and any written instructions, which may be issued relating to the event.

Eligibility

This event is open to riders who hold a valid ACU or SACU license or Trials registration and hold a current driving license for the machine they enter. Riders must also be a member of the GMC&CC; overseas riders, a 2 day membership is included in the entry fee. The event is open to solo machines only.

Foreign riders must have a current license and Start Permission from their own Federation and proof of FIM cover.

Entries

The entry list will be limited to a maximum of 100 riders accepted in order of receipt. Entries to be sent to: Miss Elisha Benstead Debut, 4 Albion Court, Vale Road St Sampsons Guernsey GY2 4DJ

Entries must be received no later than **Friday 8th March 2019**. Should you enter after this date you will be charged a late entry fee or you may be refused an entry.

Entries must be submitted on an ACU entry form accompanied by a fee of £30 which includes 2 day club membership for overseas and £25 for local riders.

Entry forms available online or from contacting us via the above contact details.

Please note it is the rider's responsibility to complete the form correctly.

Technical Inspection

All machines must be ready for examination in the pits not less than 30 minutes prior to the start. All competitors must ensure that their machines are compliant with the Guernsey road traffic act, the responsibility for which rests solely with the rider.

Signing Or

All competitors must sign on and collect their numbered bib no less than 30 minutes before the scheduled start. ACU license, trials registration and start approval (if applicable) must be shown. If you wish to enter a team for the 'Best Team' award please do so at this time – any 3 riders, any route permissible.

Course/Route

The trial each day shall consist of a maximum of 60 sections and 3 laps . The trial shall consist of a mixture of land and beach sections.

Sections will be marked accordingly:

Expert: Red Arrows

B+: Red/Blue Arrows (mixture of expert and clubman sections depending on what is indicated on the start card) **Clubman:** Blue Arrows

Novice Premier: Blue/Green Arrows (mixture of clubman and novice sections depending on what is

indicated on the start card) **Novice:** Green Arrows

This trial includes the use of public highways. The route shall be clearly marked by orange arrows. The competitors must follow this route in its entirety and sections must be ridden in the correct sequence as per start order, competitors failing to do so will be excluded.

This event is routed along and across public rights of way competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other users. Be especially careful near horses slow down stop and cut your engine. The island speed limit differs from 15mph to a maximum of 35mph. All riders must adhere to these limits at all times.

Method of Marking

TSR 22 -A

All Observers decisions are final. Please do not argue with an observer. They give their time free of charge and stand in the cold for hours on end so our event can go ahead so please be extra courteous.

Time Limits

Saturday Sections Open 10.00am to 4.30pm (6.5hrs)

Sunday Sections Open 11.00am to 4.30pm

(5.5 hrs)

Please be aware that sections will open and close according to the times above and penalties will be incurred for

any rider who fails to complete all sections within the time limit stated. Time penalties will be issued at a point for each minute the rider is late up to a maximum of 20 minutes.

Crash Helmets

Riders must wear crash helmets at all times when riding their machines.

Third party insurance is necessary by law to meet road traffic requirements and this is the sole responsibility of the competitor.


